IHSCGA Red Pride Winter Guard Invitational

Contest Information Saturday, January 20, 2024

CONSTRUCTION:

We are under construction, but the flow is 99% the same as before. The only changes will be that the entrance and exit of the equipment area is a little smaller and the headquarters area has been moved to our LGI room. You can see this on the map.

GUARD CHECK-IN:

Enter through the North Entrance at Door 21. Doors will be open at 9:30am. The director of each unit must check in and complete their declaration form at the guard entrance before allowing students to get off the bus. If you have not completed an announcer/spiel sheet online, you will be asked to do that at this time. All participants, prop help, and chaperones must enter the building through Door 21. As per IHSCGA procedures, each guard unit receives 2 passes for their bus and equipment drivers and 8 additional tickets for prop people, chaperones, staff, etc., in addition to your declared number of performers. Wristbands will be used.

Additional prop people, chaperones, etc. will be charged \$3.00 for students and \$10.00 for adults at this entrance. ALL Adults paying the full admission price at check-in will be issued a spectator wristband. Truck and Bus Drivers will receive a wristband that will allow them access to the spectator seating.

PARKING:

Busses will park on the NORTH side of the school. Look for the band tower. Director parking is on the EAST side of the school near the main entrance (door 1).

GENERAL SPECTATOR ADMISSION:

All spectators will park in the South parking lot near the bell tower/stadium. Doors will open at 9:00AM. All spectators will enter the building through the doors located on the SOUTH side of the building at Door 7 near the bell tower. Admission price is \$10.00 for spectators. Children 5 and under are \$3, infant in lap is free.

HOMEROOMS:

Homeroom areas will be in hallways. Please do not leave valuables in the homerooms area. Changing areas will be provided. See Map.

GYM/TIMELINE/WARM-UP:

Please see the map below.

The Warm-up area will be held in our field house that split into an A and B warm up location. The goals will be up. Groups will be allowed to use music during the second half of their warm-up time per IHSCGA guidelines.

There will be a HORIZONTAL timeline utilized for this contest. Entrance to the competition floor will be from the back left as you look at floor from the spectator side and exit will be on the front left.

HOSPITALITY ROOM:

This will be located in the lobby of our auditorium located just inside door 1. Directors and instructors only with IHSCGA Badges please. Bus and truck drivers will be given a food coupon to redeem at the concession stand. The driver rest area will be in the media center.

PROPS AND EQUIPMENT:

Props will enter the building through Door 21. This is the same door as check-in. This entrance will have 3 sets of double doors with the posts removed for larger props. No one will be allowed to enter the building without a wristband or pass, so please communicate this with your volunteers. The prop loading area will begin in the large hallway that goes throughout the length of the school into a small section of the cafeteria. Please plan to load your equipment immediately following your performance. All props must pass inspection in compliance with IHSCGA rules. Props that are not in compliance will not be permitted in the gym until they pass inspection. Please make sure your props and equipment have rubber tips and padding. If something doesn't pass inspection, we will try to tape what we can. If we cannot ensure that our gym will not be damaged from props or equipment, it will not be allowed in the gym.

RECAPS/CRITIQUE:

You must sign up for critique before the contest through your CompetitionSuite account. Sign up will begin Wednesday at noon prior to the event and close at 5:00pm on Friday the day before.

Critique with the Overview Judge will begin at 2:30pm for Cadet, Festival, and Regional A Round 1. Critique for groups in Regional A Round 2, A, and Open will begin 15 minutes after the last guard has performed. (Approximately 6:45pm) Scores will be available via your CompetitonSuite app as soon as the awards are announced.

LOADING AND PROP EXIT: The prop loading area will begin in the large hallway that goes throughout the length of the school. Please plan to load your equipment immediately following your performance.

<u>AWARDS:</u> Awards will begin at 1:48pm for Cadet, Festival, and Regional A Round 1. Awards will begin at 6:28pm for Regional A round 2, Class A, and Open. Make sure that your representatives meet prior to awards in the hallway nearest the guard entrance to the gym.

<u>CONTEST HEADQUARTERS:</u> The LGI room will be utilized as contest headquarters. In the event that a host is not in the LGI room, there will be a contest volunteer that will have access to a radio to contact one of the hosts if needed.




